MSc in Telecommunications 2027

Applications are called from suitably qualified candidates for the above programme commencing in January 2027.

Eligibility Requirements:

- B.Sc. Engineering degree of University of Moratuwa, in a relevant field as judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate, **OR**
- Any other Engineering degree in a relevant field and equivalent to (1) as judged by the Faculty, and approved by the Senate, **OR**
- A minimum three year full-time degree from a recognized university, specializing in a relevant field, **AND** a minimum one year experience in a relevant field after graduation, both as may be judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate, **AND** successful performance in the placement examination of the programme, **OR**
- A professional qualification of a recognized professional institute in a relevant field **AND** a minimum of one year of appropriate experience after obtaining such qualification: the acceptability of the professional qualification of the candidate, the recognition of the institute and the relevancy of the field for this purpose shall be judged by the Faculty and approved by the Senate.

Duration: 2 years (part-time, weekends)

Composition: 1st Year – Coursework; 2nd Year – MSc Research

Note: Students must obtain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and satisfy all compulsory credit requirements at the end of the first year to proceed to the MSc research component. Students who do not meet these requirements will have the option to fall back to the Postgraduate Diploma, subject to fulfilling the required credit requirements.

Course Fee: Rs. 550,000.00

Payment Options: Payable in 4 installments:

- 1st Installment: Rs. 220,000.00 – before commencement of the programme
- 2nd Installment: Rs. 130,000.00 – before commencement of the 2nd semester
- 3rd Installment: Rs. 75,000.00 – before commencement of the 3rd semester
- 4th Installment: Rs. 125,000.00 – before commencement of the MSc research component

Additional One-Time Fees:

- Registration Fee: Rs. 1,000.00
- Examination Fee: Rs. 500.00
- Library Fee: Rs. 2,000.00 (In addition, a refundable deposit of Rs. 2,500.00 per book is applicable)
