5.1 Title of Award:

Master of Science

5.2 Participation in the Academic Program:

- 5.2.1 A candidate must satisfy the requirements for the award of the PG Diploma in Telecommunications and must have obtained an overall GPA of at least 3.0 at the PG Diploma / M.Sc in Telecommunications examinations.
- 5.2.2 A candidate shall undertake an individual research project as assigned by the Department on a specific area, for a period of not less than 9 months on a part-time basis or 4 months on a full-time basis.
- 5.2.3 Participation in seminars in the program is compulsory unless otherwise approved.

5.3 Evaluation of the research project

- 5.3.1 Examination of dissertation, evaluation of the seminar and oral examination of the candidate by a panel of examiners.
- 5.3.2 The grading for the research project will be A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, I, F.
- 5.3.3 All pass grades carry 25 credits for the research project.

5.4 Award of the degree

A candidate is eligible for the award of the M. Sc. degree if he/she,

- (a) Has obtained 40 credits from the PG Diploma/M.Sc. in Telecommunications course including 28 from compulsory subjects.
- (b) Has successfully completed the research project and obtained 25 credits for the project.

5.5 Date of Award

Date of award of the M. Sc. degree will be the first day of the month after the successful completion and evaluation of the research project.
